

Definition of Disability

According to World Health Organization (WHO, 1980), Disability means, "Any person unable to ensure by himself/herself wholly or partly, the necessities of a normal individual and/or social life, as a result of a deficiency either congenital or not, in his/her physical or mental capabilities".

According to Persons with Disabilities Act of 2008, "the disabled, including those with long term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which in interaction with various barriers may hinder their full and effective participation in society".
